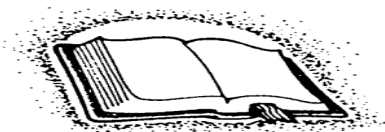

From Brittany Taylor's Desk.....

Hello and Happy Easter from Sandusky Life Teen,

I hope this bulletin letter finds you and your family rejoicing this Divine Mercy Sunday. As spring arrives, and I approach the end of my first year with Sandusky Life Teen, I cannot help but be filled with joy over what the Holy Spirit is doing within the ministry.

In today's first reading we hear accounts of how the Holy Spirit is working through the Apostles. Each Apostle was open to God's will, and through that openness, God was able to cure the sick and move within the hearts of His faithful.



That same Spirit is alive and working within our Sandusky Churches and within our Tri-Parish Life Teen ministry. We have seen on average over 40 teens from Perkins, Sandusky, SCCS, Danbury and Margaretta at every Life Night. These teenagers have also begun to participate in other ways around the parishes. More and more teenagers are being trained as Liturgical Ministers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. They are also getting involved as leaders too. We had 12 teens volunteer to lead the St. Mary's eighth grade Confirmation retreat and 19 for the Sts. Peter and Paul, Holy Angels Confirmation retreat. I have heard from several eighth graders that they enjoyed having the teens present and hearing about how they live out their Catholic Faith in High School.

This past Lenten season and during the Triduum, Sandusky Life Teen encouraged teens and their families to dive deeper into traditional forms of prayer. Several participated in Vespers with Bishop Blair on March 13, 2010 at Holy Angels, and many families spent time in front of the Blessed Sacrament in Adoration at Sts. Peter and Paul on Holy Thursday. Lastly, the high school students proudly led the Living Stations of the Cross on Good Friday for all three parish communities.

Many of our teenagers have decided to dedicate a weekend this spring or summer to be with Christ. Six juniors and seniors participated in Teens Encounter Christ (TEC). Each teen has come back more engaged and a better leader of the faith thanks to this amazing retreat. We have also had more teenagers than ever before sign up to participate in a Steubenville Youth Conference. It is awesome to witness teenagers making their faith formation a priority in their summer plans.

Every time a teenager gives of themselves and their time he or she is standing up for their faith and becoming a witness to the community. They are saying "yes" to Christ and visibly showing their love for Him through their sacrifices. Whether the teen knows it or not, with their "Yes" the Holy Spirit is moving through them, and working miracles of faith.

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, I pray that we as Catholics can open ourselves up, like the Apostles, to God's infinite mercy and love. Please continue to pray for the teenagers and CORE Team of Sandusky Life Teen as we strive to lead teens closer to Christ.

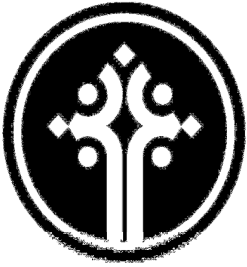

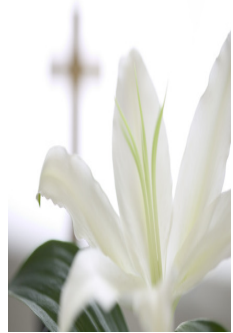
