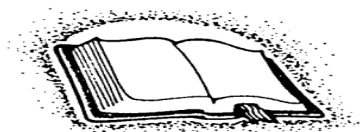

Tuesday, July 13th: Join in for prayer and faith sharing from 7:00-9:00pm at Holy Angels Church.

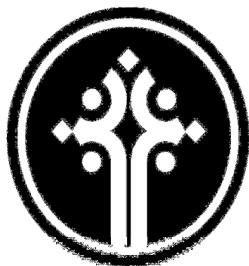
