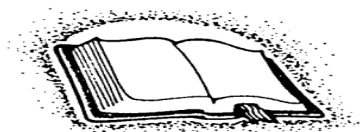

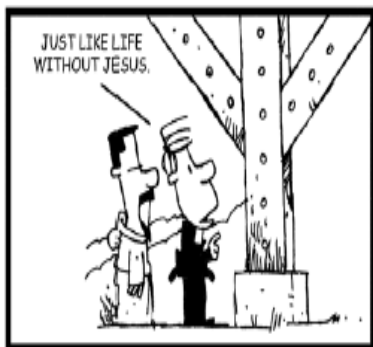

## Hello From Sandusky Life Teen!!

I pray that this bulletin letter finds you and your family having an enjoyable, relaxing and faith-filled summer. This summer has been jam-packed with incredible social, and spiritually based activities for Sandusky Life Teen.



In order to update you on all of the happenings in a timely manner I will be breaking this letter into different sections.

**SUMMER CALENDAR:** As the spring semester came to a close in May, we decided to create the first ever summer calendar of events, which included Tuesday Night Prayer and Wacky Wednesdays. Every Tuesday night the teenagers gathered together to discuss topics such as keeping Christ first in their lives, the Eucharist and Adoration along with diving deeper into the Gospels. Every Tuesday, the teens were introduced to different forms of prayer that they can incorporate into their daily prayer life, including learning how to pray extemporaneously, the Rosary, Praise and Worship, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Adoration. Wednesday evenings became the time of the week for the teenagers to break away from work and obligations to come and socialize. The two most memorable Wacky Wednesday adventures were the pool party at Briarcrest, where two CORE Team members and several teenagers decided to have a cannon-ball contest, and the Ice Cream social at Tofts, where a two-hour, impromptu game of Samurai was played. Overall, the summer calendar has strengthened faith-lives along with creating lots of crazy memories.

**SANDUSKY LIFE TEEN'S SUMMER ASSISTANT:** The summer began with a unique opportunity to hire an individual to assist me with the Summer Calendar activities. Sandusky Life Teen brought on Mr. Michael Bialorucki, a recent college graduate from Bowling Green State University and native to Sandusky, to assist throughout the summer. Michael was assigned two large jobs; to plan and execute the summer calendar, along with remodeling the Upper Room Teen Center at Holy Angels. This freed me up to plan the 2010-2011 year, along with the time to prepare for our Steubenville Mid-America trip. With Michael's time with us drawing to a close, I want to personally thank him for the many hours, prayers and hard-work he has given. His deep spiritual life, along with his dedication to leading teenagers closer to Christ has left a lasting impact on this Life Teen movement.

**STEBENVILLE MID-AMERICA:** The most powerful weekend of the summer, and quite possibly of the year was our pilgrimage to Steubenville Mid-America in July. We had 20 teenagers and seven adults travel with Sandusky Life Teen to Springfield, Missouri for a weekend dedicated to Christ. Here our teenagers truly opened up to the Gospels, and the presence of Christ in the Eucharist like never before. In the words of one of our teenage participants: "This was the most amazing encounter of God I have ever had in my life." My personal prayer for this pilgrimage is that the teenagers return to Sandusky on fire with the Holy Spirit and ready to spread the Good News to their brothers and sisters at their school and Parish community.

**MISC. INFORMATION:** Sandusky Life Teen has begun to take advantage of technological advances and have begun to send out Mass-Blast text messages daily to our teenagers. This is a way to keep scripture and prayer in their minds. It has also assisted with reminding teens about upcoming events and prayer requests. Starting in September, Sandusky Life Teen will also be emailing out weekly E-Newsletters to participants and their families. If you would like to receive either the Text Message updates or the E-Newsletter please speak with Brittany. Anyone is welcome to receive these updates on your Tri-Parish youth ministry. Lastly please keep your eyes on the Sandusky Life Teen Bulletin Section every week. We have recently been posting information on the progress of our Upper Room Teen Center transformation.

*Please continue to pray for us, as we pray for you.*

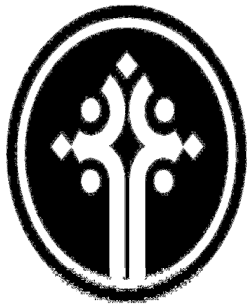
